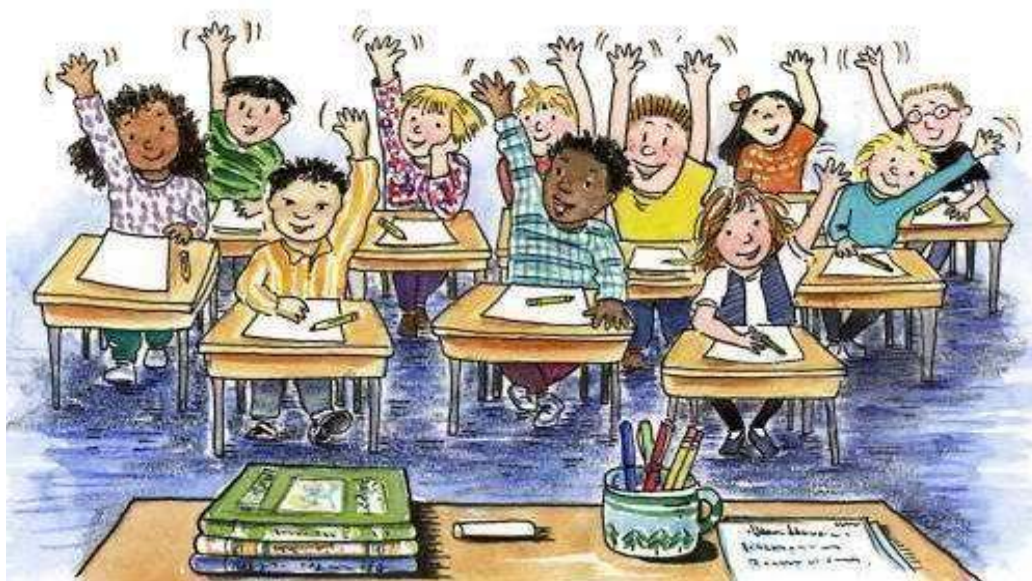


Stay positive WYN! (What's Your Name) _____

It's not so bad, says the policewoman; so please tell us all why we are even here today..

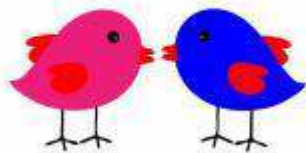
Oh yeah, it's easy, to stay positive of course!..

Ok, says the cop; but she's just my work partner, like I say..

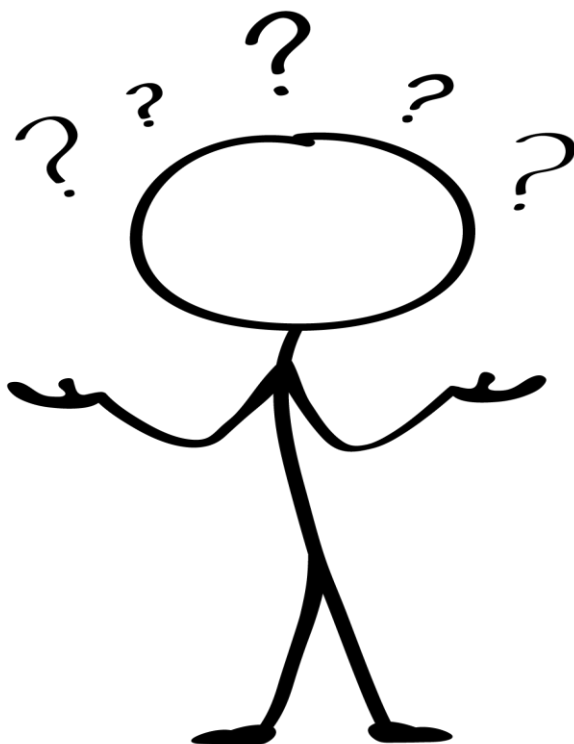
Sure, says the teacher, it's what I meant to say, but anyway..

Hi everyone! Says Officer Charlie Brown..

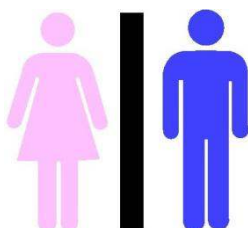
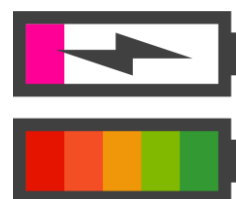
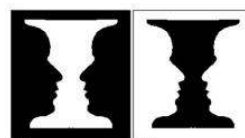
Ok says the policeman, so now with all that confusion out of the way; who can remember a positive face and a negative face that we can create?

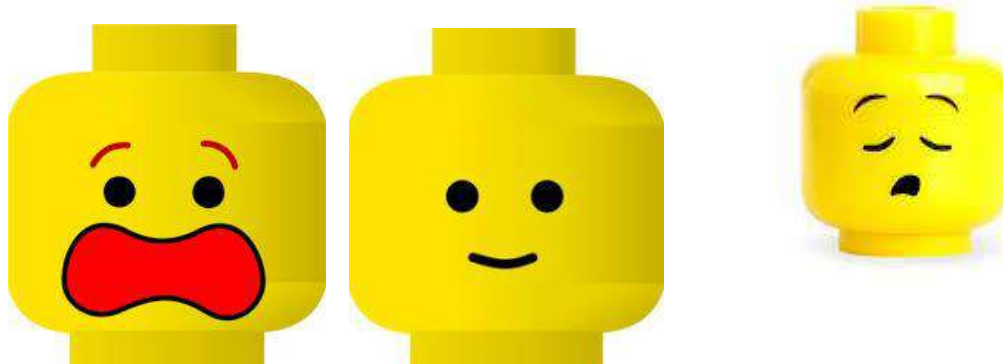
Positive! Say the children, less negative says the teacher, more understanding! Says Officer Charlie Brown..

[Please circle which one of these faces you think the policeman is thinking right now]

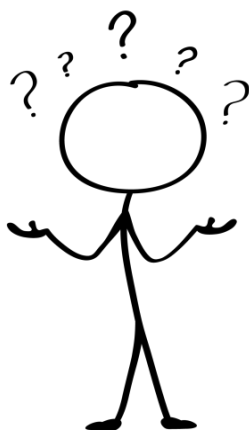

Acting in a negative way to get what we want is called using our negative power points. Like crying for an ice cream and getting it that way because you're basically making all the people around you crazy in a way if you don't stop crying! Or complaining..

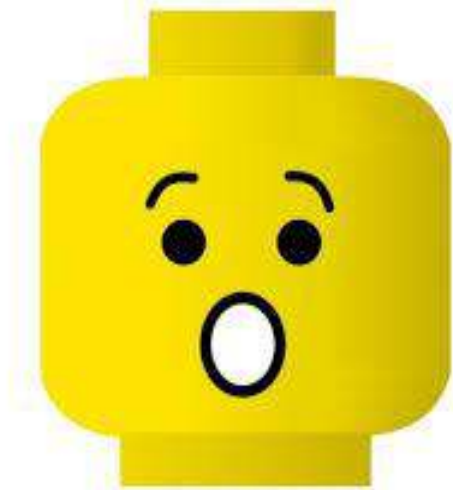
Yeahh, well that was my mistake, says the policeman. But a good example of something negative leading up to something positive.. Just saying.. What are you doing after work today?
